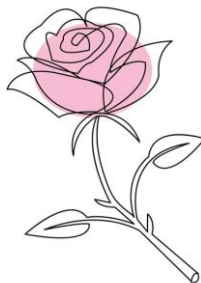

Under the guidance of Principal Sir Mr.George P.S. The event was a successful.

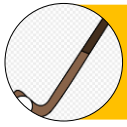


Janmashtami Celebrations (26th August)

“Wisdom is giving children their wings, along with the rudder of awareness to keep them safe from the prying hands”

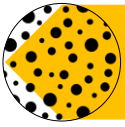

Open Parents Day after PT-1 Examinations conducted on 10th August to discuss academic progress of the children with parents. PPT of school activities shown on the smart boards to parents

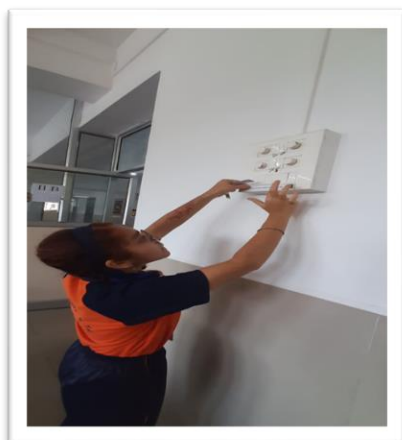
