Date : 05-04-2025



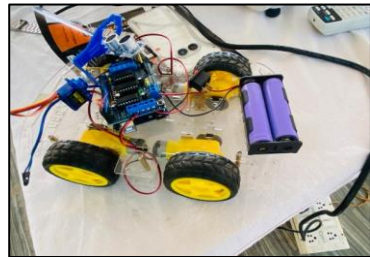

The Exposure Visit Programme, an initiative by CBSE under NEP 2020 for Principals of CBSE Schools held on 20th March 2025 was really an eye opener on the possibility of resource, technology and knowledge integration between CBSE Affiliated Schools and Higher Educational Institutions. Encouraging the incorporation of vocational and skill-based education into the mainstream curriculum will definitely help us in achieving the objectives of NEP and solve the dearth of skills, employability and generation of wealth and knowledge.

Aligning with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the visit to the University of Delhi was an interesting one and focused on integrating skill-based education into the school curriculum.
